64th NATIONAL ROLLER SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025-26:

Date-Venue-Disciplines-Rules & Regulations for the Championships

With further reference to National News-1 Dated 10/10/2026, we are happy to inform that the **64rd National Roller Skating Championships** is scheduled to be held from 5th to 15th December 2026, at Karnataka-hosted by Karnataka Roller Skating Association under the aegis of Roller Skating Federation of India INDIA SKATE Age Groups-**Cadet- Sub Junior-Junior-Senior-Masters** & Schedule is as follows:

THE CHAMPIONSHIP WILL BE CONDUCTED AS PER THE GOVT. REGULATIONS AND NORMS PREVALENT AT THE TIME OF THE EVENTS.

A > PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY: Only RSFI-recognized Units or individuals are allowed to participate. RSFI may accept direct entries in disputed cases or in cases where there is no RSFI-affiliated State/UT Unit. Skaters must participate only from the State/UT where they meet one of the following criteria: (i) **Students:** A student studying in a school, college, or any institution recognized by the State/Central Government is considered an ordinary resident of the State/UT where the institution is located. (ii) **Employees:** An employee working in a public sector

institution or government office/department is considered an ordinary resident of the State/UT where their workplace is situated. (iii) **Others:** Individuals not covered under categories (i) or (ii) above can only represent the State/UT where they are domiciled.

Skaters who are debarred or suspended by RSFI are not eligible to participate.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: ELIGIBILITY AND AUTHORIZATION FOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPATION

In accordance with the Government guidelines and the speaking order issued on August 13, 2026, the Ministry has released the official list of recognized State/UT Associations and their authorized office bearers.

Please note the following critical directives regarding participation in the upcoming National Championship:

a) Authorized Associations Only: Only the State/UT Associations and office bearers explicitly named in the Ministry's list are authorized to register and send teams for the National Championship. Any entry submitted through an unlisted or unauthorized body will not be accepted.

b) Official Verification: For absolute clarity, the Ministry's order dated 13/08/2026, along with the complete schedule of recognized, legitimate, and authorized State/UT Associations, is available on the official **RSFI website at WWW.INDIASKATE.COM**. All participants must verify the legitimacy of their state association through this portal.

c) Compliance Requirement: All athletes, coaches, and officials are strictly advised to operate solely through these legitimate channels. You must ensure you compete under the correct, recognized platforms and forward your official entries for the National Championship exclusively through the proper, authorized state organization.

Entries received outside of this proper channel will be deemed invalid.

B> PLAYING KIT & SKATE INSPECTION TEAM EVENTS: All the team event players/skaters must report at the venue 90 minutes before their match time for their Playing kit & Skate Inspection.

C> Age eligibility: A Skater should be at least 6 Years of age as on 31st December 2026 to be eligible for participation in their respective age group. Jumping to Upper Age Group shall not be permitted.

D> Skaters Annual Online Registration: All the skaters participating in the activity of Roller Sports at club/District/State/UT level must be registered with RSFI for 2026-27. Every skater has to register/renew on or **before 31st October** of the current calendar year through the online portal of RSFI (www.indiaskate.com) and pay/remit an amount of Rs.350/- per annum by the Gateway payment portal of RSFI towards Annual Skaters Registration Fee. The online registration/renewal starts from **1st January of the Calendar year. The registration is valid from 1st January to 31st December** of the calendar year and is to be renewed annually.

E> Date of Birth/ e-Aadhar as DOB Certificate, e-Aadhar based Authentication

is required for the purpose of establishing the identity & Date of Birth of the skater with RSFI and not for any other purpose. Copy of e-Aadhar of all skaters (including for those above 18 years) to be submitted to the RSFI Championship Committees along with Entry Form. Age Group determination is as on 31.12.2026.

Please note all participants shall submit the same e-Aadhar copy which was uploaded for the RSFI Annual Skaters Registration. There shall not be any mismatch in the name given in the e-Aadhar with School/ College records. The e-Aadhar submitted must be in English or Hindi only, not in local language. Original e-Aadhar must be produced immediately for verification as and when required by the said committee.

F>Technical Rules: As per practice, International Rules corresponding with Federation's RSFI 11 RR & latest adopted rules by RSFI will be followed in the 63rd Nationals.

Please Note the following updates/corrections:

(i).Inline Freestyle Skating: Reference 11RR Annexure-D, Note 3. Clarification: Out of the 08 skaters, one pair can be formed to participate in Pair Skating from each state/UT in each age group of 12-15, 15-18, and Above 18 in these age group with any of the given combinations, 2 Boys or 2 Girls or 1 Boy and 1 Girl. No additional skater can be added as the 9th skater to form a pair team.

ii).Roller Derby: Reference 11RR Annexure-E- Note 8. Maximum of teams allowed from each age group for Roller Derby 12-18 Junior Girls & Above 18 Senior Women and **Above 12 Senior Men** are one (1) team from each State/UT.

G>Events(Disciplines) & Age Groups – Boys/Men and Girls/Women : Tiny Tots - Cadet - Sub Junior - Junior-Senior-Masters: As per latest RSFI 11 RR.

Events(Disciplines): Speed Skating, Artistic Skating, Roller Hockey, Inline Hockey, Inline Freestyle Skating, Skateboarding, Roller Freestyle Skating, Inline Downhill, Inline Alpine, Roller Derby & Roller Scooter(Scootering). Skate Cross*
*Demo event.

AGE GROUPS: Male/Female as per Annexure "F"

NOTE:

i). **PARTICIPATION IN HIGHER AGE GROUP:** Skaters are to participate in their own age group. Jumping to Upper Age Group shall not be permitted. However, for International trials **Junior skaters are allowed to participate in seniors age group.**

ii).Masters Age Group: (a).For Masters age group, in both Men and Women, the entry is open to participants of previous Speed National Championships, who has completed the RSFI 2026-27 Annual Skaters Registration formalities through their respective State/U. T Unit. (b).He/She should be a Above 35 years as on 31st December 2026. (c).Skaters Above 35 years may participate in Senior's category, but once participated in Masters he/she has to participate in Masters for ever.

H> Special Children (Mentally Challenged):

Special Children (Mentally Challenged): Two Speed race/event will be conducted for these special children for Nationals. Separate race for Inline and Quad skates. Quad

skaters cannot participate in Inline races and vice versa.

Age Group: 6 to 8, 8 to 10, 10 to 12, 12 to 15, 15 to 18, Above 18 years Boys/Men & Girls/Women.

Event - Speed Skating - Track Race:

For 6 to 8 & 8 to 10 age group: 1 Lap + D Race & 2 Lap + D Race.

For 10 to 12, 12 to 15, 15 to 18 & Above 18 age group: 1 Lap + D Race & 500M +D Race.

A skater can participate in two races.

Maximum Skaters allowed for all age groups from each State/U. T in both Boys & Girls are:

For Quad: 2 Boys & 2 Girls, For Inline: 2 Boys & 2 Girls

i.e. maximum skaters allowed from each State/UT in **Quad** are 12 Male & 12 Female, total 24 and maximum skaters allowed from each State/UT in **Inline** are 12 Male & 12 Female, total 24.

A Maximum of 48 Skaters are allowed from each State/UT. The State/U.T shall select the team and submit the Entry online to RSFI. There is no Entry Fee for the Special Children for participating in the Nationals. But the participants must complete the RSFI 2026-27 Annual Skaters Registration formalities. Copy of e-Aadhar and Disability Certificate* also required.

*** Disability Certificate also required #** issued by the competent State/Central Government authority i.e. District Medical Board/State Medical Board (consisting of a panel of Government Doctors) and or Unique Disability ID Card(UDID) (a National digital proof issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Govt. of India) to prove that the participant is Mentally Challenged person.

Specifies the type of disability (e.g. Intellectual Disability, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Mental illness) and percentage of disability. Minimum 50% & above disability only will be considered.

I> Entry: The 64th National Roller Skating Championship Entry to be done online. Please go to the website www.indiaskate.com and login with the password given to your Unit. Please note, the online entries of teams will be accepted & approved only if the 2026-27 Annual Online Registration (2026-27) Application number of the skaters is entered in the online Championship Entry Form. Fill up each entry carefully, scan the Photo & Date of Birth certificate and upload it. After completing & uploading all the Entries online, take a printout of the entries. One copy of the hard copy of Entry to be signed & Sealed sent through the team manager for submission to the Championship Committee office at the respective National venue. The original Date of Birth Certificate to be produced by the Team Manager for verification, at the time of submission of the documents, one day before the National Championship. The Annual State/U.T Affiliation Fee & Skaters Entry Fee to be paid by Demand Draft, drawn favouring **"Roller Skating Federation of India"** payable at New Delhi.

Entry opening Date > 20th October 2026

Entry Last Date > 20th November 2026 is the last date for online entry portal.

J> Payments of Fees: The State-UT Units' affiliation fees & skaters/team entry fee (as per RSFI 11RR) are to be given at the time of reporting. The mode of Payments is Demand Draft , the drafts are to be drawn favoring **"Roller Skating Federation of India"**. or the payment can be made online thru WWW.INDIASKATE.COM and details to be sent to RSFI email. At the back of the said demand draft/s, name of the State/UT and purpose for which payment is being made is to be mentioned. Payment made by ordinary cheque/cash will not be accepted.

K> General:

(i).Skaters/s who are not selected or are under suspension or have disciplinary action pending against them, shall not be eligible to participate in the Nationals.

(ii).Skaters are to bring wheels suitable for use on all kind of floors including Asphalt/ Asphalt Coated, Cement - Kota - Cudappa Stone - Tandur Stone - Mosaic - Tarmac - Wooden surfaces etc.

(iii). TEST/ELIMINATION:

Prior tests /elimination may be held in any of the disciplines to achieve quality participation in the championships. Sub-standard participants will be eliminated as per participation eligibility criteria/rules RSFI. To uplift the standard of skating and face challenges of international competitions and to discourage substandard skaters, Judges and referees at the Nationals may introduce Elimination round/Qualifying Time/ Points /Marks/ Conduct Skating tests for allowing participation in the Nationals. Skaters found sub- standard will not be allowed participation. e.g. All Hockey players must perform skating and basic hockey skill at the start of Hockey match before National referee/s. If the skater is found substandard then he/she will not be eligible to participate.

(iv). MANAGERS AND COACHES: Each team is allowed one manager, one lady manager (if girls are participating) and one coach. The Manager and Lady Manager must Compulsorily be present during the Managers meeting during the Championship/Tournaments. In case if the championship is held in multiple state/Ut then one more Manager/Lady Manager/coaches may be nominated by the State /Ut Associations.

It is suggested that the U.T/State Associations appoint a Physio or any medical attendant for the state team players.

The Team Manager/Coach appointed for the U.T/State team should be able to maintain a code of conduct during the national Championship, as we have seen in past, inappropriate conduct towards judges, officials, Organisers and other participants Parents & coaches of the skaters. In case of unacceptable behaviours, the concerned athlete will be liable of facing a penalty & disqualification.

(v). Disrespectful (e.g. sexual, violent, insulting) movements or gestures, especially towards the judges or during Opening/Closing/Medal ceremony, are not appropriate and the skater can be penalised or disqualified.

(vi.) It has been decided by the competent authority that wherever a female athlete is part of the team, it is mandatory to have at least one female Coach/Support Staff for the same discipline. We are requested to nominate the female support staff to be part of the contingent.

(vii).If a skater is not present for the podium ceremony the skater is automatically suspended from participation in the next race/event and loses all the points for the general rankings (individual & state).

(viii).Medical Fitness Certificate, to be submitted by all participating skaters/players and team officials, Date of reporting 4th/6TH /7th December.

ix).Team uniforms are to be worn exclusively by team members, including team officials, during the Championships. Conditions laid down in RSFI 11RR Clause 10.09 must be adhered to when placing any company's name or logo on a skater's shirt

during the national competition. (No Alcohol, Tobacco & Anti-Social, Company Sponsorship and Religious sign/symbol)

x). No team/player will be allowed to participate in the National Championship with below/substandard kit/equipment/gear.

L> Dope/Drug Test: may be carried out at random on players to ensure drug/ dpe are not used by them to enhance performance. Anti Doping Rules of NADA is applicable to all participants. Please see RSFI website in this regard. **All Skaters shall be ready any time for Dope Test.**

M> Managers/Coaches Meeting: will be held between 5 to 7 p.m. on the day of reporting to discuss arrangements made for The Championships/ Clarification of Rules/ Announcement of program/ and the Championship Schedule etc. Respective RSFI Technical Committees proposes to conduct clinics for participating team coaches/managers.

N > Accident/Medical/Life/Insurance Policies: Please note that for any injuries/losses caused to Participants/Officials /accompanying members during Championships/ on or off the playing area, RSFI and or Organisers/ Host Association and or its officials shall not be responsible and or liable to meet any expenses/ damages whatsoever. **All the participating skaters, officials and accompanying members must take adequate accidental, medical and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with themselves.** Every team must carry First Aid Kit.

O>Lodging and Boarding: Hosts will arrange subsidized lodging and boarding. Teams wishing to avail lodging must confirm by 20 October 2026.

P> Formalities: On the date of reporting: Team Managers on arrival are to report to championship committee and complete the formalities such as:-

- a). Confirm the Online Entry made and pay the State/U.T annual affiliation fee/ skaters' entry fees/ security deposit for boarding and lodging.
- b). Submit photocopy of proof of Date of Birth Certificate of all Skaters.
- c). Submit signed & sealed copy of online 2026-27 Annual Skaters' Registration Form of all skaters.
- d). Collect the Race Numbers/ Chest Numbers.
- e). Submit details of team's return journey date, time and mode of transport being used.
- f). Hand over Team Flag (2 numbers) for the March past/ hosting (Size approximately 4 X 3 feet).
- g). Hand over the Team Over all Rolling Cups/Trophies received during the 62nd Nationals.
- h). Submit Medical Fitness Certificate
- i). Copy of Valid Insurance copy of all Participants & Team Officials
- j). Submit Oath form of all Participants

Note: Managers shall ensure that all participating Skaters and team officials maintain **exemplary discipline** and also participate in the **March past rehearsal and Inauguration** as advised by the Organisers of the Championship.

> RSFI Strictly follow> No March Past No Events Policy

For the National Championships, an event will be conducted only if there are entries from a minimum of three different States or Union Territories (UTs). Even if the total number of entries are three but not from three different States/Union Territories (UTs), the event will not be held, and the entry fee will be forfeited.

Q > Minimum participation rules for holding the competition: Only for disciplines which are medal events in Nationals for less than 5 years the event can be conducted even there is only 1 participant or 2 team. For the events which are in Nationals for more than 5 years the minimum criteria for conducting the events is minimum 3 participants in case of Individual events and three teams in case of team events. Ranking will be given on the basis of criteria decided by the respective committees.

R > Minimum Qualifying timing/points/marks for Nationals:

>Speed Skating, there is a minimum timing criterion as under.200mts track(rink) timing in Seconds. Minimum qualifying time for National:

Quads: 6-8 (38), 8-10 (35), 10-12(33), 12-15(30), 15-18 (28) & Above 18 (26) (Seconds).

Inline: 6-8 (37), 8-10 (34) 10-12 (32) 12-15 (29), 15-18 (27) & Above 18 (24) (Seconds).

>Artistic Skating Skater must Perform All four basic edges one leg turns, two leg turns, recognized jumps and basic spins, also skaters should have proper attire.

>Roller & Inline Hockey, please send only deserving skaters in the team. Do not add below standard skaters to fill up the empty places in the team.

Skaters need to have basic skills of Roller & Inline Hockey & they must clear the Basic framework of the skills which include Forward & Backward Skating, Braking, Dodging, Shooting and Ball/puck control. Also both Roller & Inline Hockey skaters should have proper kit & safety equipment to participate.

-For **Inline Freestyle Skating**: For **Classic Slalom**, skater must perform all four basic edges one leg turns and perform a variety of slalom tricks that include sitting, spinning, wheeling and other tricks, etc.

-For **Speed Slalom** event there is a minimum timing criteria as under for 20 cones
Minimum qualifying time for National: 10-12 (7.0), 12-15 (6.5), 15-18 (6.0) & Above 18 (5.5) (Seconds)

Other Games: CRITERIA

Skateboarding: Roller Derby: Roller Freestyle: Inline Downhill: Inline Alpine;

Scootering: as per 11RR , In case any player/team fails to clear the technical round conducted by technical committee, can be disqualified at any given point of time.

S> Claim(Protest) Fee: For National Championship an amount of Rs.5000/- per

claim, for Speed/Artistic/Inline Freestyle Skating/ Roller/Inline Hockey/Other Games, shall be enclosed along with every written claim made to the concerned technical Committee Chief referee. The claim must be made by the Team manager/lady manager within 15 minutes before the start of the event or within 15 minutes after announcement of the result. Without disturbing the schedule and depending on the availability of time and concerned records the Technical Committee/ RSFI shall decide the matter. In case the claim is upheld the fee will be returned.

T>Force Majeure: In case of any unforeseen circumstances if daily schedule is changed and or events remain incomplete, decision taken by the Federation's Technical Committee shall be final and binding on all the teams.

U>Reporting of Teams: The State/U.T teams shall inform the organizers well in advance regarding the arrival/departure details. The teams may plan their arrival and departure dates as per respective discipline schedule.
